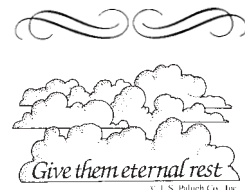

Little Flower Catholic School and Parish Office will be closed Monday and Tuesday for Mardi Gras.



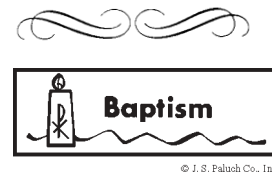

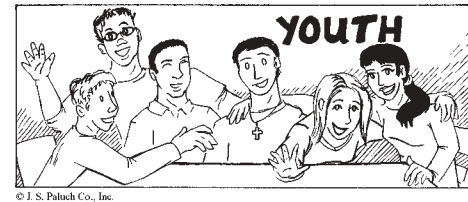

Catholics over 14 years of age are bound to the obligations of abstinence. Meat may not be eaten on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays during Lent. Catholics over 18 years of age to the 60th birthday are bound to the obligation of fasting. Only one full meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one’s needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed.

Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence.
